Worship Sunday's at 10:00 Someone tells of seeing geese flying south in a <u>V formation</u>. Why do they fly that way—why not in a cluster? Two aerodynamic engineers wondered the same thing so they set up a wind tunnel experiment to find out. They quickly discovered that as each bird flaps its wings it creates an uplift for the birds that follow. By flying in V form, the whole flock ads 71% greater flight range than if each bird flew on its own. When a bird falls out of formation, he suddenly feels the weight of trying to go it alone!
